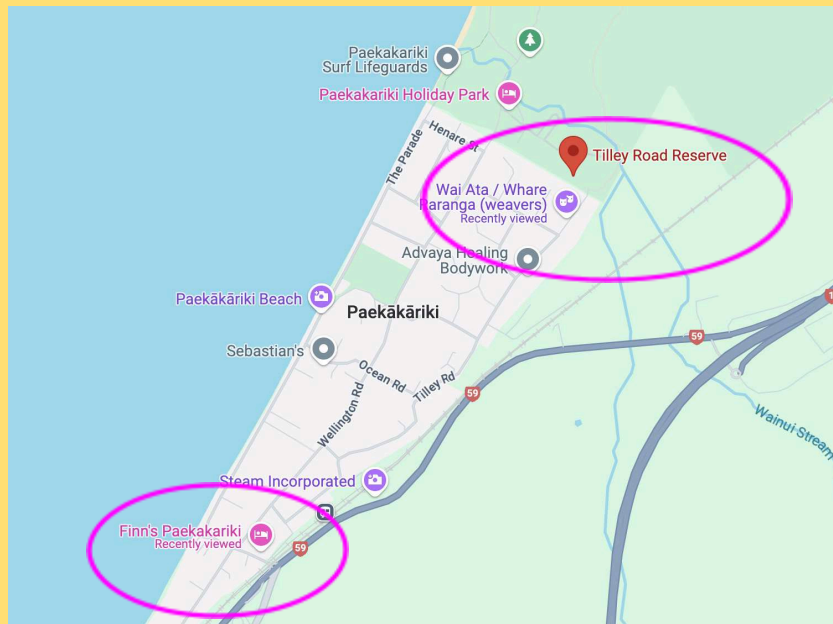
**KOHA** If you are able please consider bringing a cash koha to support the festival costs. We are a small grass-roots core who love uplifting this mahi & supporting artists.
